



## Employer's Incentive Payment Form (Apprenticeships)

The Government's Apprenticeship Employer Incentive scheme for England currently provides a flat rate £1,000 incentive to employers who recruit an apprentice aged 16-18, and certain apprentices age 19-24. In order for the college to be able to transfer the £1,000 incentive to the employer, the employer will need to provide the college with their bank details.

## Criteria

- At the time of sign-up, Apprentices must be aged 16 to 18. Apprentices who are aged 19-24 who have previously been in care or have a current Education & Health Care Plan (EHCP) are also eleigible.
- The Incentive is payable irrespective of the level of the apprenticeship or the size of the employer
- To qualify for the full payment the apprentices must be on programme for twelve months
- The £1,000 per apprentice incentive will be paid in two equal instalments after the qualifying periods, which are three months and twelve months
